We again have been allocated parking through Gate 1 (main entrance to Ingliston House) You go up old road past British car Auctions, turn right and then follow signs for the tarmac area at the back entrance to the Lowland hall, where you will bring your machines through **(NO RUNNING ENGINES WITHIN THE BUILDINGS PLEASE)**

You can arrive from 10am until 8.30pm on Friday 10th March. On arrival you will be allocated your place at booking in table along with your weekend passes and free tea or coffee. **Any late arrivals must be notified in advance or they will not be allowed entry. (2 free weekend tickets per motorcycle when booked in)** Please remember that as a matter of safety no children under 16, or dogs are permitted on the Friday. No exhibits or machines may be moved before close of show on Sunday for safety reasons **(no exceptions)**. We will post your entry number(s) and vehicle pass in due course to allow you to unload and register.

Show will be open 9.00am to 5pm Saturday and Sunday

Please note: Rules for Judging are that the machine should look and be as close to original manufacturer's production specification as possible. (Standard categories)
