Due to the success of last year running machines will be allowed at certain times in allocated places we would like a machine from each club to let the public hear them.

To enter as a Club, please complete this form and return it as soon ASAP to ensure you have a space. In 2017 all category winners will receive a payment, Best Stand will receive £150. Best Bike in Show £200. We again have been allocated parking through Gate 1 (main entrance to Ingliston House) You go up old road past British car Auctions, turn right and then follow signs for the tarmac area at the back entrance to the Lowland hall, where you will bring your machines through and also car park 6 where you can offload your machines and bring them in (**NO RUNNING ENGINES WITHIN THE BUILDINGS PLEASE**)

You can arrive from 10am until 8.30pm on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> March. On arrival you will be allocated your place at the booking in table along with your weekend passes. **Any late arrivals must be notified in advance or they will not be allowed entry. (Please note 2 free weekend tickets per motorcycle booked in)**

Please remember that as a matter of safety no children under 16 or dogs are permitted on the Friday. No exhibits or machines may be moved before close of show on Sunday for safety reasons (**no exceptions**).

We will post your entry list form and vehicle passes in due course to allow you access.

Show will be open 9.00am to 5pm Saturday and Sunday.

Please note: Rules for Judging are that the machine should look and be as close to original manufacturer's production specification as possible. (Standard categories)

Reserve your space early to ensure a space by completing the above form by 1<sup>st</sup> February 2017.
